- I. Roll Call: Commissioners Stevie Clark, Tammy Dillon and Kevin Lipford absent.
- II. Commissioner Weatherford moved for approval of the December 2010 County Commission minutes.  
Second by Commissioner McNeil.  
The motion passed by voice vote.
- III. Commissioner McCullar moved that Askew, Hargroves, Harcourt and Associates be hired to do the engineering work on roads covered by the block grant per the recommendation of the road board.  
Second by Commissioner Moore.  
The motion carried by voice vote.
- IV. Commissioner Wheeler moved for approval of the following requests from Sheriff Buck; A. the request from 911 to attach a 60 foot tower on the east side of the Justice Center; B. An improvement to the entry on the Sheriff's side of the building; C. the construction of a wall in the break room area for the two offices. These request were approved and recommended by the Building Committee.  
Second by Commissioner Weatherford.  
The motion was approved by voice vote.
- V. Commissioner Wheeler moved that Heathcoat and Davis be hired as the engineering firm for the regular round CDBG Adamsville Project. Community Development Partners LLC would be hired to provide administrative services for this project. These firms were recommended by the Building Committee.  
Second by Commissioner Jeff Lipford.  
The motion carried by voice vote.
- VI. Per the recommendation of the Building Committee, Commissioner Wheeler moved that SWTDD provide the administrative services and TLM provide the engineering for the county's Energy Efficiency CDBG proposal.  
Second by Commissioner Brown.  
The motion was passed by voice vote.
- VII. Commissioner Wheeler moved that Keystone Construction Services be awarded the bid for work on the Latta building in the amount of \$1,065,000. No local money is involved in this bid.  
Second by Commissioner McNeil.  
The motion was approved by voice vote.
- VIII. Commissioner Rickman moved to approve the transfer of \$40,000 from the Drug Control Fund to other equipment in the Sheriff's budget per the recommendation of the Budget Committee.  
Second by Commissioner Moore.
